
Credit Freeze or Fraud Alert?


Credit Freezes is the best way to protect against an identity thief opening new accounts in your name. When a freeze is in place it prevents creditors from accessing your credit report. Creditors usually won't give you credit if they can't check your credit report. A freeze can also be helpful if you've experienced identity theft or had information exposed in a data breach. A credit freeze will not affect your credit score or ability to use your existing credit cards, apply for a job, rent an apartment, or buy insurance. You can lift the freeze temporarily. A freeze lasts until you lift it.

Fraud Alerts doesn't limit access to your credit report, but informs businesses to check with you before opening a new account in your name. Usually, that means calling you first to make sure the person trying to open a new account is you.

VETERANS' BANNERS—CENTER STREET

This year for Memorial Day week Manassas City has granted Veterans' Service Organizations (VSOs) the opportunity to place banners (two sided, 24" x 48", weatherproof) honoring our *local* deceased Veterans on utility poles along Center Street in Old Town Manassas. A photograph of the deceased Veteran along with their name and a brief description will be on one side of the banner and the other side will display the VSOs' emblem. Historic Manassas, Inc. (HMI) will place the banners on the poles at no cost to the VSOs. The cost of the banners will be borne by each individual VSO wishing to participate.

At this time the City has limited the total number of banners to 12. Post 10 will purchase a maximum of five (5) banners at a cost of \$99.00 per banner (voted on at the last General Membership meeting). *Robert V. McMaugh*, *Bill Aumen*, *and Bill Carruthers* are the Honorees to date; other submissions will be accepted for consideration by any Post 10 Family member in good standing and must be <u>received by 2 March 2022</u>, include a digital image of <u>excellent</u> quality of the Veteran, military service including dates, campaign, and medals/awards received. Final decision will rest with the Executive Board.

If all goes well in future years we may be able to display many more banners with photos and names of our deceased Veterans the length of Center Street.

You can also update your profile information: address and phone number. You need your permanent membership ID number to start an account at mylegion.org. If you have a hand written card, you probably have a temporary number. Email me for your permanent number.
- 2. By mail. If you've received your renewal request from National Headquarters, mail it to Post 10 at 9950 Cockrell Road, Manassas, VA 20110 attn: Post 10 Membership. If you haven't received a form from National Headquarters, send a check, and a note with your name, ID number, address, email and phone number.
- 3. In person. Stop by Post 10 and ask the bartender for a membership envelope, fill out the envelope, include your membership number and dues.
- 4. Legion dues are \$35.00 and your new 2022 membership card will be mailed to you. Please provide your address, email and phone number. It's important to be able to contact you. Your information is stored in a protected database, accessible to only the post officers with the need to know. If you have an email account, and can receive the newsletter electronically, it will save the Post money. Please feel free to email me.

For those members who renew on line: You are able to print out a card immediately with your receipt. That is all the proof you need to show that you are a member in good standing for the new membership year. The card is valid for all purposes. I will send out a card with my name on it once I am notified by National that payment has been made.

Military Suicide Prevention: Gaps in DOD's Mental Health Care System Being Filled by Reddit

The suicide rate for young military service members aged 18-24 in 2020 was more than double that of civilians in the same age bracket, and higher than those of all age demographics among civilians, according to Department of Defense data and findings recently released by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. In the past five years alone, the suicide rate among active-duty servicemembers overall has increased by 41%. Although young people in the U.S. report the highest level of social media use of any demographic among the U.S. population, neither the U.S. Army nor the DoD has an official system in place to respond to reports of mental health harm or distress online. The systems that are in place such as suicide hotline numbers are often defunct, or only reachable during normal business hours. An unofficial subreddit, R/Army at https://www.reddit.com/r/arm, run by current and former U.S. Army personnel has been forced to fill the gap left by an unresponsive DoD, providing counseling to service members struggling with thoughts of self-harm.

The members of this subreddit are occupying this role without any funding or payment, and have systematically documented the serious incidents they have encountered. Although the moderation team and users of the subreddit have saved multiple lives and attempted to inform the DoD of flaws in their suicide prevention program, the DoD has not officially responded. Disability compensation is available for Veterans exposed to hazardous materials. Exposure to contaminants or environmental hazards poses a major health concern

for Veterans of all eras. If you served in Iraq, Afghanistan or other areas and believe you were exposed to hazardous materials – including particulate matter, burn pits



and others – disability compensation and other VA benefits for related illnesses or conditions may be available for you.

Our goal is to give you guidance and assistance. It is very important that you know that you must sign and complete a "Appointment of Veterans Service Organization as Claimant's Representative (also called "power of attorney" form). This authorizes The American Legion to assist Veterans and beneficiaries. Additionally, please send your full and complete contact information.


